## **Camping, Motor Homes and caravans**

Folk Gathering Temporary Camp site – Alstonefield Playing Field - available for ticket holders only.

Opens 13.00hrs Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> Sept. Site to be cleared by 13.00hrs Monday 19<sup>th</sup> Sept.

Camping will be operated and stewarded by the Folk Gathering team. Located in centre of village near to the main venues - £5.00 pppn basic with tap and elsan toilets and cwd point .

Must be booked in advance with the Folk Gathering office but pay on arrival.

All proceeds from the playing field site go to Alstonefield Parish Council. The adjacent Annie Bonsall's field will also be available and operated by the Folk Gathering Team.
